[2 Pet. 3:9] Concerning God's ability Apostle Paul wrote that God "is able to save to the uttermost." [Heb.7:25] The Bible says God is, "great, mighty, majestic, magnificent, glorious, and sovereign over all the sky and earth and He has dominion and is over all as the head of all." [1Ch 29:11] Thus we conclude that God is both willing and able to save all men and will save all men.

This is the revelation of God's Plan, Purpose, Power and Pleasure to do all that He has determined to do. He will not lie. He can not fail! All things are subdued that God may be all in all! [Is. 46:10, 57:16; Heb. 6:18; 1 Cor. 13:8, 15:28]
